### **Project Description:**

The results of National examinations still informing poor performance of students in Mathematics and science subjects. The reasons and factors affecting are many including lack of interest among the students, inadequate number of teachers etc. This project is therefore aiming to contribute to better results among the students, building their foundation for next level academic performance. This project is focusing kids from the age of 4-14 years old.

**Work:** Volunteers are expected to be teaching assistance and not replacing existing teachers in the respective institutions. The volunteer is expected to perform the following tasks. i) To plan lessons in advance ii) To create learning scenarios that catches the interest of the students iii) To stimulate the students desire to learn Mathematics and or Science subjects iv) To assign homework to ensure that the mathematics and or Science subjects taught that day was understood v) To conduct small groups sessions or one to one sessions when necessary vi) To back track-track math education for some students in order for them to understand

current lessons vii) To give tests & examinations that meets the standard qualification for the mathematics and or Science subjects curriculum at the school. Volunteers are expected to join activities for about 6-8 hours a day. Sometimes is very flexible and it can be less or more.

**Requirements:** i) Appropriate skills to teach Mathematics, English or/and Science to pre and primary schools students (4-14 years old) ii) Interested to work with young people iii) Interested in other cultures iv) Eager to learn and share v) Patient and committed vi) Creative and flexible vii) Open minded and good team player viii) Able to work under less supervision and minimum resources ix) Have English Language skills and an interest to learn the local Language (Kiswahili).

**Food:** Three meals will be provided to the volunteers either at the accommodation or work placement. Vegetarian meals will be available.

**Accommodation:** Volunteers will be accommodated in host families and you should expect to share room with either host family members or other volunteers.

**Pocket money:** None

**Insurance:** Not provided. Volunteer needs to get his/her own insurance.

**Fees:** 350 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport or bus station, orientation at the UVIKIUTA Youth Hostel, local transport to the project, food and accommodation during the program. The fee also contributes to running basic activities taking place during the project.

**Visa:** Required. UVIKIUTA will process it in the country before your arrival. The cost is of volunteer's responsibility.

**Others:** Volunteers will be picked up in Zanzibar Stone town on the 6th July 2020 at 16:00 hrs. More specific meeting point will be communicated to you after acceptance. \* Participation fee 2020: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
