<b>Theme:</b>	North-South solidarity
<b>Location</b>	Nansana, near Kampala
<b>Duration:</b>	minimum 1 month; not available during holidays May, mid-Aug to mid-Sep and Dec to early Feb.
<b>Application:</b>	The Volunteer will get a decision within 5 working days upon receipt of application form.

### **Project Description:**

The school was established in February 2007. Since then it recruited 13 teachers and there are about 200 pupils from the age of 4-13. The school is a non-governmental institution and has no financier. Aim: to improve literacy and give the volunteer a feel of the education system in Uganda.

**Work:** Mainly teach Math and English. Play games and sports with children. Participate in music, dance and drama programs.

**Hours:** The volunteer will work from 08.00 to 16.00 Monday to Friday

**Requirements:** Experience in teaching desirable but not necessary. Affinity to children. Adaptable to local teaching culture in Uganda.

**Food:** Depending on the accomodation chosen, the volunteer will share and cook meals with the family or prepare their own meals at the guest house.

**Accommodation:** Volunteers can stay at UPA Guest house. Possibility to arrange for host family. Project is at walking distance (10 mins) from the guest house.

**Pocket money:** None

**Insurance:** Not provided. Volunteer has to have his/her own insurance.

**Fees:** 500 EUR one time payment. Pick up from the airport/bus upon arrival in Uganda; orientation/training; accommodation; water; gas/electricity/charcoal; kitchen utensils; admin/communication; evaluation with host project. 500EUR for 1-3 month, 80EUR for each additional month.

**Visa:** A tourist visa must be applied online and it is purchased at the airports entry point. It costs 50 USD for up to three months.

**Others:** Most of the children at the age of 7-12 will be able to speak English. The teachers at the school speak English.

Note: All volunteers choosing school projects should always remember to consider the school holidays: mid-April - mid-May, mid-August mid-September and December to early February.
