### **Project Description:**

Trust Future Uganda (TFU) is an indigenous registered non-governmental organization established in 2009 to provide support to OVCs (Orphans and vulnerable children), disadvantaged youths and women by laying emphasis on education, health and economic empowerment. Its Vision is to bring about positive mandates for transformation among the youths/children for a better prosperous future by reducing cases of domestic violence, poor nutrition, sexual abuse, etc in the communities. Trust Future is mainly operating as a school.

**Work:** \* Teaching activities i.e. art work, physical education and English. \* Project management: planning, implementation, monitoring, defining budget and evaluation, finding new sources of sustainability. \* Field work: social work in the communities, meetings and interactions with our beneficiaries (advice and prevention), guidance and psychological support. \* Journalism: in order to create awareness among the social network, you will collect and write short interviews

and positive stories of Trust Futures members either staff, or beneficiaries (Humans of Trust Future). \* Marketing / communication: strategic marketing and operational, promotion of the projects, creation of promotional supports (video, brochure, flyers, business card, ), promotion of volunteering (through also voluntarism) and internship, writing job description of volunteering opportunities, finding international market for Women empowerment craft products, etc.

Office hours are from 8:30am - 4:00pm.

**Requirements:** \* Emotionally strong. \* Ready to interact with the marginalized vulnerable and neglected positive and negative children. \* Ability to work with children and youths. \* Able to work with communities of special cases. \* Experience/ability to handle a class is an advantage.

**Food:** Depending on the accommodation chosen, the volunteer will share and cook meals with the family or prepare their own meals at the guest house.

**Accommodation:** Volunteers can stay at UPA Guest house. Possibility to arrange for host family. The project site can be reached by boda boda (motorcycle taxi) in about 15 minutes (count about 6'000 UgSh per day).

**Pocket money:** None

**Insurance:** Not provided. Volunteer has to have his/her own insurance.

**Fees:** 500 EUR one time payment. Pick up from the airport/bus upon arrival in Uganda; orientation/training; accommodation; water; gas/electricity/charcoal; kitchen utensils; admin/communication; evaluation with host project. 500EUR for 1-3 months, 80EUR for each additional month.

**Visa:** A tourist visa must be applied online and it is purchased at the airports entry point. It costs 50 USD for up to three months.

**Others:** Communication at the Organization will be in English and Luganda. But there will be always someone to translate.

Project may not be available during holidays (January, April, May, August, September and December) so check ahead!
