Project Description:

Youth leadership and sports is an initiative by UVIKIUTA Youth center to offer opportunity to the young people in the community to exercising authority over themselves or others. It is the project targeting youth development in which young people gain skills and knowledge necessary to lead civic engagement, education reform and community organizing activities. The project is expecting to use youth friendly delivery methods that includes various sports, music, arts, workshops etc.

Work: Organizing and teaching various sports, games, songs and dances for groups of children and young people. Working with local youth volunteers in coordinating weekly Youth talks. Co-organise and coordinate various youth passion projects like arts, music performance, exhibition, workshops etc. Participating in various Youth community action activities including volunteering, awareness raising on various issues etc.

Requirements: Potential volunteer should have: skills and knowledge on sports

and Youth issues. English language skills and an interest to learn the local Language (Kiswahili). Interest to work with teenagers and Youth. Open minded and ready to be challenged. Interested in other cultures and local realities. Patient and committed, Creative and easy to adopt to the situations. Able to work under less supervision and minimum resources

Food: Three meals will be provided either at the host family/accommodation or the project site. Vegetarian meals will be available.

Accommodation: Volunteers will be accommodated in a host family. Another option would be to stay in the local youth hostel, 2-4 volunteers per room. The volunteers should be ready for both options depending on the availability.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Not provided. Volunteer needs to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 350 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport or bus station, orientation at the UVIKIUTA Youth Hostel, local transport to the project, food and accommodation during the program. The fee also contributes to running basic activities taking place during the project.

Visa: Required. Apply for the relevant visa before arriving Tanzania. UVIKIUTA will provide an official Invitation letter, for which we need a copy of Scanned passport pages with personal details, updated curriculum vitae (CV) and Motivation letter.

Others: *Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays will be free for volunteers for personal activities including exploring regional cultural and natural attractions. *Volunteers are expected to join activities for about 6-8 hours a day. Keep flexibility in mind since you might be required join activities for less/more hours. * Participation fee 2019: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
