### **Project Description:**

Our volunteer program offers opportunities to work as a volunteer, experience different cultures, meet people from different countries, learn new or improve skills, take part in peace making and hands-on on various community based development projects. We work through our website and publications, our training and our public awareness campaigns. We are seeking an enthusiastic and skilled volunteer with an interest in volunteerism as a tool for sustainable development to support our Communications team in our press, campaigning and digital activities.

**Work:** Media and Communication volunteer will be responsible for: Ongoing assignment to research write and layout for press release, posters, pamphlets, e-newsletter, website, social media, display content and media articles. Post regular updates to UVIKIUTA social media outlets, including news, articles, blog post, press releases, fundraising appeals, any other promotion items, Developing twitter/ social media hashtags.

**Requirements:** Interest in the mission of UVIKIUTA volunteering program and desire to support its mission to increase public support and number of volunteers. Excellent English communication skills (Both written and spoken). Proficient in Microsoft office and solid background in electronic communication tools. Knowledge of social media. Enthusiasm and creativity. Criminal check Certificate and Motivation letter.

**Food:** Three meals will be provided either at the accommodation or work placement. Vegetarian meals will be available.

**Accommodation:** Participants are expected to be hosted in local host families within the community. However depending on the availability of the families, in some cases Participants will be sharing accommodation in community residential house.

**Pocket money:** None

**Insurance:** Participant must have their own insurance.

**Fees:** 350 EUR per month. The fee covers airport pickups and orientation on arrival, local transport to the project (one way), food and accommodation during the program. It also contributes to the running cost of program activities before, after and during the project.

**Visa:** Apply for the relevant visas/Permit before arriving Tanzania. UVIKIUTA official invitation letter is essential. For that, we need to receive a copy of Scanned passport pages with personal details, updated CV and Motivation letter.

**Others:** \*Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays will be free for volunteers for personal activities including exploring regional cultural and natural attractions. \*Volunteers are expected to join activities for about 6-8 hours a day. Keep flexibility in mind since you might be required join activities for less/more hours. \* Participation fee 2019: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
