Project Description:

(1) Pemalang Village Library; provide a shelter for kids to read book that donated by people from all over Indonesia. (2) Mobile-Library; bring books to children living in remote area nearby camp site (3) Raising local involvement in education; open discussion, public campaign trough community visit, cultural exchange.

Work: Create fun atmosphere for kids to learn in Library by storytelling, games, drawing, etc. School campaign about the importance of literacy, or other local issue. Volunteer also will help kids learn English, and world culture.

Requirements: - be super minded - learn more about disabilities before coming - leave prejudice behind and show initiative - there is no minimum age, but if you are under 18 yo, you need to attach letter permit from parents.

Food: self cooking

Accommodation: Volunteer house will be provided by local community with shared toilet and bathroom, sleeping bag and mattress needed, and self-cooking.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Volunteers are requested to bear their own health and travel insurance.

Fees: 230 EUR per month. Fees covering foods, accommodation, and local transport for project, IWC T-shirt, certificate of participation, management fee and material for the camps. Please keep it in your mind that all personal expenses and free day expenses are excluded.

Visa: 1. 211 visa (social culture visa) lasted for 60 days and extendable 4 times (30 days each). however, to get this visa, we (as your sponsor) should apply a telex visa in Jakarta immigration

Others: 2. If it's too complicated, then the second option is visa on arrival (VOA) cost USD25-USD35 paid in any airport in Indonesia. this visa lasted 30 days and extendable 1 time, so he could have 60 days in total. After 60 days, he could travel to another country near Indonesia and come back to Indonesia using the free visa (he could only get it from certain airport : Jakarta and Bali are two of them).
