Project Description:

French language is becoming necessary for Tanzanians since we are sharing border with three French speaking countries. French Language is also considered important language when it comes to studies, searching for jobs, business, traveling, etc. This project is aiming to provide learning opportunity to socially and economically disadvantaged members of the community to access free basic French language courses to enable them to access various business, education and employment opportunities.

Work: Volunteers will join the Community Language classes at Youth center where various sessions will be running for maximum 2 hours each. The main tasks will be delivering lessons to community classes with a focus on practical use of French or Spanish Languages. Other tasks will be testing and grading students and find creative means to encourage learners to practice their reading, writing and speaking French or Spanish skills through group settings and one-to-one exercises. Volunteers are expected to join activities for about 6-8 hours a day.

Flexibility is highly required since you might be asked to work for less or more hours in some days.

Requirements: Volunteers should have basic knowledge in French language. Furthermore a potential volunteer should have: Commitment to treating learner with respect, Non-judgemental approach that values different cultures, Good English language skills, Strong inter-personal skills, Interest in people and their stories. And an open minded , flexible personality and the ability to work under less supervision are an added advantage.

Food: Three meals will be provided either at the host family/accommodation or the project site. Vegetarian meals will be available.

Accommodation: Volunteers will be accommodated at the local host family in the community. The host family will be able to introduce volunteers to the nuances of life and the food and culture. Volunteers are expected to be part of the family and not guest!

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Not provided. Volunteer needs to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 350 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport or bus station, orientation at the UVIKIUTA Youth Hostel, local transport to the project, food and accommodation during the program. The fee also contributes to running basic activities taking place during the project.

Visa: Required. Apply for the relevant visa before arriving Tanzania. UVIKIUTA will provide an official Invitation letter, for which we need a copy of Scanned passport pages with personal details, updated curriculum vitae (CV) and Motivation letter.

Others: *Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays will be free for volunteers for personal activities including exploring regional cultural and natural attractions. *Volunteers are expected to join activities for about 6-8 hours a day. Keep flexibility in mind since you might be required join activities for less/more hours. * Participation fee 2019: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
