## **Project Description:**

Arts and designing for Livelihood is project that aim aims to support local small business initiatives that specialize in a variety of different products such as tailoring, decorative items, drawing, jewelry, mat woven, food etc. The small business owners on which most of are women and young people already have a market for their goods and services but are in need of support in helping them to extend their product range, designing display them physically or in a brochure to attract more sales and also to look at branding and quality.

Work: Over the course of this program volunteers will work with local business owner to help to improve and develop the range of products and how they are marketed at a social enterprises. Based on the volunteers individual skills and interest, below listed activities will take place. Research new techniques and generation of ideas for new products in the particular business. Deliver training sessions on new techniques or designs for local artisans and small business owners. Development of marketing strategies to promote sales and/or raise awareness of

art products and the social enterprise. Assist with production and sale of local arts and crafts products. Deliver training on business plan development and business management.

Requirements: Volunteers are expected to be creative and studying either an arts based course, designing, tailoring, marketing, sustainable development or just interested to experience those topics and activities. You should be as well open minded, flexible, ability to work under less supervision and limited resources. Kindly bring a positive attitude, lots of ideas, and a willingness to work as part of a team to make the most out of this project.

**Food:** Three meals will be provided either at the host family/accommodation or the project site. Vegetarian meals will be available.

**Accommodation:** Volunteers will be accommodated at the local host family in the community. The host family will be able to introduce volunteers to the nuances of life and the food and culture. Volunteers are expected to be part of the family and not guest!

Pocket money: None

**Insurance:** Not provided. Volunteer needs to get his/her own insurance.

**Fees:** 350 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport or bus station, orientation at the UVIKIUTA Youth Hostel, local transport to the project, food and accommodation during the program. The fee also contributes to running basic activities taking place during the project.

Visa: Required. Apply for the relevant visa before arriving Tanzania. UVIKI-UTA will provide an official Invitation letter, fo which we need a copy of Scanned passport pages with personal details, updated curriculum vitae (CV) and Motivation letter.

Others: \*Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays will be free for volunteers for personal activities including exploring regional cultural and natural attractions.

\* Participation fee 2019: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
