Project Description:

Differences in opinions, tastes, beliefs, other social and cultural norms in today's society is obvious. Due to technology and globalization the gaps have been even wider leading to serious issues like discrimination, losing social values and traditional education and connection to the nature. This project is aiming to explore, understand, challenge and act on the cross-generational issues leading to enhancing peace, solidarity and sustainable development. The project will involve people of different generations (Younger and older) in order to exchange experience and pass on knowledge.

Work: 1. Walking and exploration of indigenous communities living on the slopes of the Mount Kilimanjaro. (Introduction to issues around globalization, environment and tourism and its impact on local economy and cultures). 2. Home stay/visits and cultural experience in a local family. 3. Working with elders, orphans and vulnerable children (storytelling, excursions, sports and community gatherings events, hygiene and cleaning, provide support on their daily

activities) to make them feeling valued, included and supported. 4. Kiswahili Language Classes, arts and Crafts. Study Part: Educational tours to destinations related to the project theme, workshops, debates and other social events involving various generations of the community will be organized. Topics for discussion will include rites of passage, modern & traditional religion and its impact on social and economic aspects of the community. Volunteers are encouraged to study the topic in advance in their own local context.

Requirements: Special Requirements Potential volunteers are expected to be outgoing, flexible, interest on other culture, willing to share, exchange stories and independent.

Food: Three meals will be provided either at the host family or workplacment. Vegetarian options will be available.

Accommodation: Volunteers will be hosted in communal house. Basic accommodation facilities will be provided. Expect to share room with or other volunteers. There is no beds, however comfortable mattresses will be laid down. Water and electricity will be available.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Not provided. Volunteer needs to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 350 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport or bus station, orientation at the UVIKIUTA Youth Hostel, local transport to the project, food and accommodation during the program. The fee also contributes to running basic activities taking place during the project.

Visa: Required. UVIKIUTA will process it in the country before your arrival. The cost is of volunteer's responsibility.

Others: * Local/project languages: Kiswahili and English * Volunteers will be picked up in Moshi town on the 19th July 2020 at 16:00 hrs. More specific meeting point will be communicated to you after acceptance. * Participation fee 2020: a) For one month: EUR350 b) For two Months: EUR500 c) For three Months: EUR700 d) For more than three months: EUR200 per month.
