Project Description:

Nansana Childrens Centre was established on 5th Jan 2011, under registration number WBO/1238/11 the pioneers are youths, parents, and Children living in Nansana Division, Nansana Municipality, Wakiso District. Its aim is to support orphans and vulnerable Children, Youths and community people both with and without HIV/AIDS and other related diseases and to Counsel, Educate, Sensitize and Empower children, women on factors affecting them such as HIV/AIDS, Family health, unwanted pregnancy, social and family matters.

Work: - Counseling of clients (Orphans and other Vulnerable Children) - Health Education and sensitization for the community - Working with other counselors in dealing with HIV/AIDS clients - Out-reach services - Attending meetings - Compiling reports - Research - Updating social platforms like facebook and web page

Working hours are 5 days a week from 8:00am-5:00pm.

Requirements: - Interest and motivation to work with children - Innovative and flexible - A Volunteer with counseling skills - The volunteer should be kind and

ready to listen, emotionally strong and to give advice if necessary - A volunteer with fundraising skills is an added advantage

Food: Depending on the accomodation chosen, the volunteer will share and cook meals with the family or prepare their own meals at the guest house.

Accommodation: Volunteers can stay at UPA Guest house. Possibility to arrange for host family. From UPA Guesthouse/Nansana to project it is 1 mile and it costs 2,000 UGX (one way) by a hired motorcycle (Boda Boda) and/or other public means.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Not provided. Volunteer has to have his/her own insurance.

Fees: 500 EUR one time payment. Pick up from the airport/bus upon arrival in Uganda; orientation/training; accommodation; water; gas/electricity/charcoal; kitchen utensils; admin/communication; evaluation with host project. 500EUR for 1-3 months, 80EUR for each additional month.

Visa: A tourist visa must be applied online and it is purchased at the airports entry point. It costs 50 USD for up to three months.

Others: This is a new LTV project.
