Project Description:

This project is organized in partnership with the Adumasa community and Bridging Gaps Beyond Boundaries a community Based Organization.

Work: Volunteers will get involved in mentorship and motivational talks to the youth and women, career guidance and counseling, help in the formation of youth and women group for economic empowerment, capacity building trainings in leadership, school outreach program for self esteem strengthening and counseling both primary and secondary schools, HIV/STI educations, rights education, formation and establishment of forum, discussions/debates on pertinent issues that affect youth and young women, economic empowerment through business skills trainings, opportunity identification and establishment of groups for micro-finance at village levels.

Requirements: Volunteers should obtain the following similar competence (skills): High school certificate, first degree or masters. Volunteers should be interested

to teach children (youth) from different backgrounds and have open mind to understand the students levels and understand the culture of the local people.

Food: Meals and accommodation will be provided for for the whole period of the project.

Accommodation: Volunteers will be hosted in the community with host families.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: VOLU will not provide insurances for the volunteers. Insurance is needed.

Fees: 250 EUR per month. Pick up from the airport/bus station, orientation, evaluation, monitoring, project set up, administrative expenses, supporting small community projects, running of activities during the project, certificate of participation, accommodation, food.

Visa: To stay 3 5 months an open tourist visa or business visa is required. VOLU will provide an invitation letter on request when the application is confirmed. We recommend that volunteers prepare all necessary documents to obtain visas themselves.

Others: Volunteers should bring along the following: mosquito net, medication, flash light, bed sheet, games, musical instruments, social/casual dresses, toiletries, sandals and shoes for their personal use, working shoes (Boots).

Volunteers are allowed to stay in the VOLU office Hostel for two weeks free of charge (one week before the project starts, and one week after the project), but will pay 10 euros for each day after this period (excl food).
