Project Description:

Yéviépé is a village of 3,000 inhabitants located 12 km from the town of Kpalimé. There is a primary school and a secondary school for pupils from six neighbouring villages.

The volunteers provide a framework for the development of the village's children through several recreational and cultural activities and also give some lessons such as mathematics, English and French to the pupils. In the afternoons, the volunteer will manage the village library by organising reading and sharing workshops with the children.

Work: Prepare lessons in collaboration with a teacher and organise support lessons Helping to correct students' papers, Monitor students during various assessments Putting the library in order Repair books, manage files (loans, reader's cards, etc) Organise reading workshops Organise socio-educational activities

Requirements: Motivation, patience, listening, autonomy, initiative, open-mindedness

Food: Provided by Astovot

Accommodation: in hosting families

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Volunteer has to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 290 EUR per month. Administrative costs, food and accommodation.

Visa: You need a visa to Togo. Information is available at the Togoembassy or consulate in your country. It is possible to obtain a visa at the airport but we recommend that you get in your country to avoid administrative complications.

Others: If possible, bring some manuals, gadgets or any educational material.
